The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Mali and has the honor to refer to the Agreement Between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Republic of Mali Concerning the Imposition of Import Restrictions on Archaeological Material from the Region of the Niger River Valley and the Bandiagara Escarpment (Cliff) done at Washington September 19, 1997 (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement").

The Embassy proposes that, pursuant to Article IV A of the Agreement, the Agreement be extended for an additional five-year period.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Mali, the Embassy of the United States proposes that this note and the Ministry's note in reply, shall constitute an agreement to extend the Agreement, which shall enter into force on the date of your note in reply and shall be effective September 19, 2002.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Malians Abroad presents its compliments to the Embassy of the United States of America at Bamako and, acknowledging receipt of its note No. 171 of September 11, 2002, has the honor to notify it of the acceptance by the Government of the Republic of Mali of its proposal to extend, for an additional five-year period, the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Mali and the Government of the United States of America Concerning the Imposition of Import Restrictions on Archaeological Material from the Region of the Niger River Valley and the Bandiagara Escarpment (Cliff) done at Washington on September 19, 1997.

Consequently, the Ministry hereby informs the Embassy that the Government of the Republic of Mali accepts the terms of the above-mentioned proposal and confirms that the Embassy's note referred to above and this note shall constitute an agreement between the two governments to extend the Agreement of September 19, 1997, which shall enter into force beginning on September 19, 2002.
