Excellency, Mr. Ambassador:

Let me extend assurances of our respect and high consideration for the Embassy of the United States of America in Poland.

I want to emphasize that the Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Republic of Poland for the Establishment of the Polish – U.S. Fulbright Commission has promoted bilateral relations as well as education, academic and cultural exchanges. I have a very high opinion of the implementation of the Fulbright Program, which has offered substantial support for studies and research of both Polish and American scholars. The resources are being invested in educating the most talented people in Polish fields of research, economy, and politics. Fulbright scholarships help people advance their professional careers, and, moreover, it is always a great intellectual adventure. Experiencing American democracy is yet one more important aspect of the scholarships that shape minds.

Consequently, in order to continue the cooperation between academic communities of both countries, I propose that you approve further implementation of the Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Republic of Poland for the Establishment of the Polish – U.S. Fulbright Commission, as drawn up in Warsaw on October 20, 1995, until a new agreement is drafted.

If you agree to our proposal, I would be obliged if you could send a reply.

Let me avail myself of this opportunity to renew the assurances of my high consideration and respect for the Embassy of the United States in Poland.
