The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Liberia and has the honor to refer to earlier discussions between representatives of the two Governments regarding the provision by the Government of the United States of America of articles and services to the Government of Liberia pursuant to section 1206 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2007 as modified and extended, or successor legislation. In this regard, the Embassy refers to the Agreement regarding provisions of United States law affecting eligibility for United States military assistance and training, effected by exchange of notes at Monrovia, February 23 and September 7, 1983.

In accordance with these discussions, it is proposed that the Government of Liberia agree:

1. That the terms and conditions of the aforementioned agreement shall apply to articles and services provided pursuant to 1206 of the National Defense Authorization Act

for Fiscal Year 2007 as modified and extended, or successor legislation.

2. That the Government of the United States of America may also, from time to time, make the provision of articles and services furnished under other authority (except the United States Arms Export Control Act) and for other purposes subject to the terms and conditions of the aforementioned agreement. (Transfers under the United States Arms Export Control Act shall continue to be governed by the requirements of that Act and United States regulations applicable to such transfers.)


The Embassy proposes that if the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of Liberia, this note and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Liberia's note in reply shall constitute an agreement between the two Governments, which shall enter into force on the date of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Liberia's note.


