

**AGREEMENT**

**BETWEEN**

**THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE OF  
THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**

**AND**

**THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC**

**CONCERNING**

**THE PROVISION OF ASSISTANCE FOR COUNTERTERRORISM,  
MILITARY AND STABILITY OPERATIONS**

The Department of State of the United States of America (as the "grantor") and the Ministry of Defense of the Czech Republic (as the "recipient"), hereinafter referred to as the "Parties":

recognizing their need to cooperate in the conduct of counterterrorism operations; and

desiring to support military and stability operations;

Have agreed as follows:

## **ARTICLE I OBJECTIVE AND SCOPE**

1.1. The objective of this Agreement is to set out terms for use of articles and services transferred from the grantor to the recipient for purposes of counterterrorism and military and stability operations pursuant to section 1206 of the United States National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2007, as amended and extended, or successor legislation.

1.2. The grantor may also make the provision of articles and services for the same purposes furnished under other authority subject to terms for use set out in this Agreement.

## **ARTICLE II OBLIGATIONS OF RECIPIENT OF ARTICLES AND SERVICES**

2.1. The recipient shall not, unless the consent of the grantor has been first obtained:

2.1.1. Permit any use of the articles or services referred to in Article I by anyone not an officer, employee or agent of the recipient;

2.1.2. Transfer, or permit any officer, employee or agent of the recipient to transfer, such articles or services by gift, sale or otherwise; or

- 2.1.3. Use, or permit the use of, such articles or services for purposes other than those for which provided.
- 2.2. Articles or services referred to in Article I shall be returned to the grantor when they are no longer needed for the purposes for which they were furnished, unless the grantor consents to another disposition.
- 2.3. The recipient shall pay to the grantor the net proceeds of sale received by the recipient in disposing of, with prior written consent of the grantor, any article referred to in Article I, including scrap from any such article.
- 2.4. The recipient shall, as the grantor may require, permit continuous observation and review by, and furnish necessary information to, representatives of the grantor with regard to the use by the recipient of any article or service referred to in Article I.

### **ARTICLE III SECURITY**

- 3.1. The recipient shall maintain the security of articles and services referred to in Article I.
- 3.2. The recipient shall provide substantially the same degree of security protection afforded by the grantor to the articles or services referred to in Article I.


### **ARTICLE IV FINAL PROVISIONS**

- 4.1. This Agreement shall enter into force upon signature by the Parties.
- 4.2. This Agreement may be amended upon the written agreement of the Parties.


