

OSCC Decision No. 2/02
To The Treaty On Open Skies
Accession of the Republic of Finland
to the Treaty on Open Skies

The Open Skies Consultative Commission,

Having received from the Depositories the application of the Republic of Finland for accession to the Treaty on Open Skies, deposited on 4 January 2002, in Budapest and 7 January 2002 in Ottawa,

Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 4 of Article XVII of the Treaty on Open Skies,

Has decided:

That the application for accession of the Republic of Finland to the Treaty on Open Skies is accepted.

In accordance with paragraph 6 of article XVII, the Treaty shall enter into force for the Republic of Finland sixty days after the deposit of its instrument of accession with the Government of Canada or with the Government of the Republic of Hungary or both.

Done at Vienna in the Open Skies Consultative Commission on 4 February 2002, in each of the six languages specified in Article XIX of the Treaty on Open Skies, all texts being equally authentic.
