

OSCC Decision No. 11/03
Supplement 1 To Decision Number One
To The Treaty On Open Skies

In order to specify the procedure for reimbursing costs incurred by the observed Party on behalf of the observing Party to facilitate the conduct of the observation flight pursuant to Article VI of the Treaty the Open Skies Consultative Commission decides:

1. In the event that the observing Party requests the observed Party to change the time of arrival at the point of entry of the observed Party, and if the observed Party agrees to such a delay, and the observing Party does not arrive at the newly established time, it shall reimburse the observed Party for the following additional costs:
 - (a) Room reservations for the personnel of the observing Party: for two days, not exceeding 60 euros pro person per day;
 - (b) Accommodation costs for up to 10 members of personnel of the observed Party, designated to support the observation flight of the observing Party: for two days, not exceeding 60 euros pro person per day.
2. Not later than 30 days after the scheduled time of arrival of the mission, the observed Party shall send to the observing Party an invoice with clear indication of costs incurred by the observing and the observed Parties in convertible currency.

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Done at Vienna in the Open Skies Consultative Commission on 16 June 2003, in each of the six languages specified in Article XIX of the Treaty on Open Skies, all texts being equally authentic.
