
Excellency:

Dear Mr. Holloway:

As you are aware, the Government of the United States of America's "Agreement for the Transfer of Title [*Acuerdo de Transferencia de Título de Propiedad*]" of two Sikorsky UH-60L helicopters and seven Bell UH-1H II helicopters to the Colombian Ministry of Defense, for use by the Colombian Army, was signed by Ambassador William R. Brownfield and Minister of Defense Juan Manuel Santos. Moreover, the conveyance for said aircraft was signed by you and General Mario Montoya Uribe, Commander of the Colombian Army.

In view of the foregoing, I wish to inform you that the legal formalities required by the Republic of Colombia for transfer of title of the above-mentioned nine aircraft have been completed. The owner of said aircraft is to be the Colombian Ministry of

Defense, following the exchange of notes between the parties regarding the completion of the legal formalities required by each country for the transfer of title.

This letter is prepared in compliance with Subparagraph D of the “Agreement for the Transfer of Title,” signed December 7, 2008.

CONVEYANCE OF HELICOPTERS

- A. Pursuant to the Agreement for the Transfer of Title between the Government of the United States (“USG”) of America and the Government of the Republic of Colombia (“GC”), hereinafter the “Parties,” signed December 7, 2007, the USG has transferred title, as a donation, of two Sikorsky UH-60L helicopters, serial numbers 0427023 and 0427024; and seven Bell UH-1H II helicopters, serial numbers 7321661, 7321719, 7322134, 7321666, 7321748, and 7422350, to the Ministry of Defense of the Republic of Colombia, for use by the Colombian Army.
- B. Pursuant to legal requirements of the Republic of Colombia, the Ministry of Defense of the Republic of Colombia, represented by the Colombian Army, hereby accepts and takes material possession of the helicopters mentioned in Section A above, in “as is” condition , and will proceed to enter them into its property inventory.
- C. The USG, represented by the Narcotics Affairs Section of the Embassy of the United States in Colombia, hereby certifies that the value of the helicopters mentioned in Section A above is US\$51,250,000, as detailed in the attached document.
