Fourth Amendment dated **AUGUST 22, 2008** to the Strategic Objective Grant Agreement, dated August 30, 2004 between the Republic of Indonesia (the "Grantee") and the United States of America, acting through the United States Agency for International Development ("USAID") (collectively, the "Parties") for Improved Quality of Decentralized Basic Education in Indonesia.

SECTION 1. The Agreement, previously amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

A. Article 3, Contribution of the Parties, Section 3.1 (USAID Contribution) is amended as follows:

i. Section 3.1(a) is amended by deleting "Ninety Five Million Two Hundred Eighty Seven Thousand One Hundred Ten United States ("U.S.") Dollars (\$95,287,110)" and substituting "One Hundred Forty Three Million Nine Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Eight United States ("U.S.") Dollars (\$143,978,488)" in lieu thereof.

ii. Section 3.1(b) is amended by deleting One Hundred Thirty Three Million U.S. Dollars (\$133,000,000) and substituting "One Hundred Forty Three Million Nine Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Eight U.S. Dollars

(\$143,978,488)” in lieu thereof.

B. The following paragraph at Section E.4. (Coordination) of Annex 1, Amplified Description is deleted in its entirety:

“USAID implementing partners may enter into working groups and memoranda of understanding with appropriate implementing GOI agencies, including local governments, to facilitate program implementation provided such actions do not contravene the terms and conditions of this Agreement [or] any contract, grant, cooperative agreement or other type of agreement entered into by USAID and its partners to implement this Objective. USAID and the Grantee acknowledge that such arrangements do not constitute a legally binding commitment on the Government of the Republic of Indonesia [or] the Government of the United States.”

C. The Attachment (Illustrative Financial Plan) to Annex 1, Amplified Description, is deleted in its entirety and the attached Attachment (Illustrative Financial Plan) to Annex 1, Amplified Description is substituted in lieu thereof.


SECTION 2. Except as specifically amended or modified herein, the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with all of its terms.

SECTION 3. Effectiveness. This Fourth Amendment shall enter into force when signed by both Parties hereto.


