New *Amoco/BP* and *Chevron* Personal Tax-Exempt Gasoline Credit Cards Currently Unavailable

The Office of Foreign Missions (OFM) recently learned that the credit agency that supports the issuance of tax-exempt gasoline credit cards for purchases of motor fuels from *Amoco/BP* and *Chevron* is no longer able to establish new personal accounts for eligible foreign mission members in the United States.

However, eligible foreign missions may still obtain tax-exempt gasoline credit cards from *Amoco/BP* and *Chevron* for official purchases of motor fuels. Thus, eligible foreign missions may continue to request as many **official/mission** tax-exempt gasoline credit cards as they determine are needed.

OFM is currently working with representatives of *Amoco/BP* and *Chevron* to determine when and if it will allow for the establishment of new tax-exempt gasoline credit cards for the personal use of eligible foreign mission members.

The foreign missions are reminded that there are 13 vendors, not including *Amoco/BP* and *Chevron*, who continue to allow for the issuance of tax-exempt gasoline credit cards for **personal** purchases of motor fuels by eligible foreign mission members.
