# 6 FAM 410 DOMESTIC EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

## Changes

1. This Change Transmittal issues an administrative change to 6 FAM 410, Domestic Emergency Management to correct a grammatical error in 6 FAM 414 and to make the corrected phrase match in 6 FAM 414 and 6 FAM 417.3.
2. Because the error was in the new material issued under CT:GS-167, we have retained all the *dark magenta italic* from that issuance for purposes of consistency. The CT line in each section shows when that section last changed.
