



The U.S. Department of State's Bureau of International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Affairs (INL) will be hosting the first annual INL Partnership Forum on Tuesday, May 14, 2013, from 9:00am to 1:00pm in the George C. Marshall Center of the U.S.

Department of State. The mission of INL is to minimize the impact of international crime and illegal drugs on the United States and its citizens through providing effective foreign assistance and through fostering global cooperation.

The forum will provide an opportunity to learn first-hand about our international criminal justice assistance and rule of law programs and meet INL program managers. INL's senior leaders will provide an overview of mission and program priorities during a plenary session followed by an informal meet-and-greet session with INL Bureau program officers.
