

The following is Amendment Two to the “Memorandum of Understanding Between the Department of Defense of the United States of America Represented by the Defense Energy Support Center and the Ministry of Defence of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland Represented by the Defence Fuels Group Concerning the Use of the United Kingdom Government Pipeline and Storage System in the Support of U.S. Forces Within the United Kingdom,” dated March 18, 2004, as amended on April 25, 2005 (GPSS MOU).

The following changes are made to the GPSS MOU.

1. Amend ANNEX F as follows.

a. Delete Paragraph F.3. and replace with the following.

“F.3. Annual JPTS Budget. DFG will provide DESC with a proposed annual JPTS budget, which the Participants will review and finalize at the quarterly meeting, for the forthcoming financial year. The budget will include a detailed synopsis that outlines the operational necessity for all DFG proposed facility projects. The synopsis will include the scope of work, estimated project cost, proposed start date, and impact if not funded.”

b. Add the following sentence to Paragraph F.9.3.

“As an attachment to the final account, DFG will provide DESC a detailed listing of all maintenance completed to the JPTS storage system in the previous year. ”

c. Add Paragraph F.11.

“F.11. DFG will immediately notify DESC in writing, to request additional funding, when a project’s actual costs are expected to exceed the project’s initial cost estimate.”

2. Amend ANNEX G as follows.

a. In Paragraph G.1.1., delete “3,103,965” and replace with “3,197,705”.

b. In Paragraph G.1.2.1., delete “4,193,748” and replace with “4,320,399”.

c. In Paragraph G.1.2.2., delete “7.67” and “1.05” and replace with “7.90” and “1.08”.
