

AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT*between***THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA***and***THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE OF GEORGIA****"CONCERNING COOPERATION IN THE AREA OF PREVENTION OF PROLIFERATION OF TECHNOLOGY, PATHOGENS AND EXPERTISE RELATED TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF BIOLOGICAL WEAPONS"**

Pursuant to Article VII of the Agreement between the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Ministry of Defense of Georgia "*Concerning Cooperation In The Area Of Prevention Of Proliferation Of Technology, Pathogens And Expertise Related To The Development Of Biological Weapons*", dated December 30, 2002, as amended in March 23, 2004, August 30, 2004, and November 3, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"), the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Ministry of Defense of Georgia hereby agree to amend Article III, Paragraph 1 by replacing the words "sixty (60) million" with the words "ninety five (95) million".


This Amendment shall enter into force upon the date on which the parties exchange written notifications confirming the completion by each Party of all applicable procedures, and it shall remain in force for the duration of the Agreement.
