To Apply:

- Return the completed application along with a non-refundable fee of US \$50.00* (payable to Endicott College) to the Madrid Program address at right.
- Arrange to have the following information sent along with your application or under separate cover:
 - Official transcripts of all academic work
 - Two letters of recommendation
 - A 250-500 word essay explaining your professional goals

Course Fees:

- \$50.00 Application Fee (submitted with application)
- \$879 per 3 credit course – Due at time of registration for each course.
 - Due at or before the start of July courses \$879 X 4 = \$3,516
 - Due at or before the start of September for online courses \$879 X 2 = \$1,758
 - Due at or before the start of January for online courses \$879 X 2 = \$1,758
 - Due at or before the start of second year July courses \$879 X 4 = \$3,516
- \$200 Graduation Fee (due April 2009)
- Books and materials for each course must be purchased by the student.

* Fees are paid only in US \$ by checks drawn on US funds, bank transfer, or credit card.
