

PROTOCOL EXTENDING AND AMENDING
THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
AND
THE FEDERAL NUCLEAR AND RADIATION SAFETY AUTHORITY OF
RUSSIA
TO COOPERATE ON NATIONAL PROTECTION, CONTROL, AND ACCOUNTING
OF NUCLEAR MATERIALS

The Department of Energy of the United States of America and the Federal Environmental, Industrial and Nuclear Supervision Service of Russia (formerly the Federal Nuclear and Radiation Safety Authority of Russia);

Taking into account the provisions of the Agreement between the Department of Energy of the United States of America and the Federal Nuclear and Radiation Safety Authority of Russia to Cooperate on National Protection, Control and Accounting of Nuclear Materials done June 30, 1995, as extended (the Agreement);

Wishing to extend the term of the Agreement for an additional term and to reflect that the name of the Russian party to the Agreement has been changed from the Federal Nuclear and Radiation Safety Authority of Russia to the Federal Environmental, Industrial and Nuclear Supervision Service of Russia; and

Acting pursuant to Article VI of the Agreement;

Have agreed as follows:

Article I

The term of the Agreement is extended for five years until June 30, 2010, unless terminated earlier in accordance with Article VI of the Agreement.

Article II

All references in the Agreement to "Federal Nuclear and Radiation Safety Authority of Russia" shall be replaced with "Federal Environmental, Industrial and Nuclear Supervision Service of Russia".

Article III

This Protocol shall enter into force upon signature, with effect from June 30, 2005.
