

AMENDMENT 2
 TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OF THE
 UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
 AND THE CABINET OF MINISTERS OF
 THE REPUBLIC OF AZERBAIJAN
 CONCERNING COOPERATION IN PREVENTING THE PROLIFERATION OF
 WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION

Pursuant to article VII of the Agreement between the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Azerbaijan Concerning Cooperation in Preventing the Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction, dated January 2, 2004, and as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"),

The Department of Defense of the United States of America (DoD) and the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Azerbaijan (COM) have agreed to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. To amend Article III by replacing the words "twenty million U.S. dollars" with the words "thirty-five million U.S. dollars."
2. THE SECOND SENTENCE OF ARTICLE IV BE DELETED AND REPLACED WITH THE FOLLOWING NEW SENTENCE:

"THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL APPLY TO ANY KIND OF ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT UNDER SUCH ARRANGEMENTS AND TO ALL PERSONNEL AND ACTIVITIES REQUIRED FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SUCH ARRANGEMENTS."

This amendment shall enter into force upon signature and shall remain in force for the duration of the Agreement.

In witness whereof, the undersigned, being duly authorized by their respective governments, have signed this amendment.

Done at Washington, this 26th day of August, 2005, and at Baky, this 01 day of august, 2005, in duplicate, each in the English and Azeri languages, both texts being equally authentic.
