JOINT DECLARATION BETWEEN THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR DEFENCE OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND CONCERNING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR DEFENCE OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND CONCERNING COMBATING TERRORISM RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT (CTRD MOU)

The Secretary of Defense on behalf of the Department of Defense of the United States of America (Secretary of Defense) and the Secretary of State for Defence of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (Secretary of State for Defence) have reached common understandings regarding the following provisions of the CTRD MOU:

1. Section I (Definitions): The definition of "Contractor" includes prospective Contractors, for the purposes of those MOU provisions addressing the transfer of Classified Information or Controlled Unclassified Information provided by a furnishing Participant. Prospective Contractors must be legally bound by the receiving Participant to protect any Classified Information or Controlled Unclassified Information provided by the furnishing Participant in accordance with the provisions of the CTRD MOU.

2. Section VI (Contracting Provisions):

a. The phrase "purposes authorized under this MOU", which appears in paragraph 6.7, includes the "Government Purposes" and "Program Purposes" uses specified in Section VIII (Disclosure and Use of Program Information) of the CTRD MOU.

b. Recognizing that paragraph 6.7 provides that (1) the transfer of export-controlled information furnished by one Participant will be authorized by the government of that Participant only to the other Participant's Contractors who will use the information only for the purposes authorized under the MOU, and (2) Contractors will not re-transfer export-controlled information to another Contractor without the consent of the government of the furnishing Participant:

(1) Subject to the provisions of Section XII (Third Party Sales and Transfers) and to any limitations specified in individual Task Plans, the U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) hereby authorizes the U.K. Ministry of Defence (MOD) to re-transfer to U.K. MOD Contractors, and to permit re-transfer to those Contractors' U.K. subcontractors, any export-controlled information furnished by or on behalf of the U.S. DoD for either "Government Purposes" or "Program Purposes" as specified in Section VIII (Disclosure and Use of Program Information) after such Contractors or subcontractors are legally bound to protect such export-controlled information in accordance with the provisions of the CTRD MOU. Subject to the provisions of Section XII (Third Party Sales and Transfers) and to any limitations specified in individual Task Plans, the

U.K. MOD hereby authorizes the U.S. DoD to re-transfer to U.S. DoD Contractors, and to permit re-transfer to those Contractors' U.S. subcontractors, any export-controlled information furnished by or on behalf of the U.K. MoD for either "Government Purposes" or "Program Purposes" as specified in Section VIII (Disclosure and Use of Program Information) after such Contractors or subcontractors are legally bound to protect such export-controlled information in accordance with the provisions of the CTRD MOU.

- (2) For any export controlled information furnished by either U.S. or U.K. Contractors to the U.K. MOD pursuant to U.S. export licenses approved by the U.S. Department of State (DoS), the U.K. MOD will obtain prior written authorization from the U.S. DoS in accordance with the terms and conditions of the approved U.S. export license prior to any U.K. MOD re-transfer to U.K. MOD Contractors for either "Government Purposes" or "Program Purposes" as specified in Section VIII (Disclosure and Use of Program Information) of the CTRD MOU.
- (3) For any export controlled information furnished by either U.S. or U.K. Contractors to the U.S. DoD pursuant to U.K. export licenses approved by the U.K. Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), the U.S. DoD will obtain prior written authorization from the U.K. DTI in accordance with the terms and conditions of the approved U.K. export license prior to any U.S. DoD re-transfer to U.S. DoD Contractors for either "Government Purposes" or "Program Purposes" as specified in Section VIII (Disclosure and Use of Program Information) of the CTRD MOU.


