

AMENDMENT THREEUNITED STATES NAVY AND CHILEAN NAVY
FUEL EXCHANGE AGREEMENT

I. Pursuant to Article XII, the United States Navy (USN) and Chilean Navy (CN) Fuel Exchange Agreement (FEA), dated October 25, 1997, respectively is amended as stated below.

II. The Defense Energy Support Center (DESC) assumed all USN FEAs effective October 4, 2002. As a result, DESC is now responsible for the administration and management of subject agreement. DESC and the CN will jointly manage the tenets of the agreement.

III. DESC and the CN acknowledge the requirement to promulgate a new agreement; therefore it is agreed:

The existing USN/CN Agreement, Section III, A, will be amended to include the following provision.

US Marine and Coast Guard ships will be extended the same fuel support as US Navy ships under the framework, policy, and procedures of this agreement.

IV. Amendment Three will become effective on the date of the last signature.
