to the Results

Package Grant Agreement, dated September 3, 1998, between the Arab Republic of Egypt ("Grantee") and the United States of America, acting through the United States Agency for International Development ("USAID") for Private Sector Commodity Import Program.

SECTION 1. The Grant Agreement, as previously amended on September 29, 1998, June 23, 1999, April 5, 2000, and September 27, 2001, is hereby further amended as follows:

A. Section 2.1 is amended by deleting "Eight Hundred Fifty Million United States Dollars (\$850,000,000)" and substituting "One Billion Fifty Million United States Dollars (\$1,050,000,000)" therefor.

B. Section 5.4 is amended by deleting "September 30, 2004" and substituting "September 30, 2005" therefor.

C. Section 8.2 is amended by deleting "Minister of State for International Cooperation and/or the Administrator of the Department for Economic Cooperation with U.S.A." and substituting "Minister of State for Foreign Affairs and/or the First Undersecretary for Economic Cooperation with U.S.A. of the Sector for International Cooperation" therefor.

D. Section 8.3 is amended by:

1. Deleting "Ministry of International Cooperation, Department of Economic Cooperation with U.S.A."

and substituting "Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Sector of International Cooperation, Economic Cooperation with U.S.A." therefor, and

2. Deleting "To USAID: USAID, 106 Kasr El Aini Street, 9<sup>th</sup> Floor, Cairo, Egypt" and substituting "To USAID: USAID, Plot 1/A Off El-Laselki Street, New Maadi, Cairo, Egypt" therefor.

E. Annex 1, Amplified Description, first line, second paragraph is amended by deleting "USAID's Egyptian counterpart agency is the Ministry of International Cooperation (MIC)" and substituting "USAID's Egyptian counterpart agency is the Ministry of Foreign Affairs" therefor.

SECTION 2. Language of Amendment. This Amendment is prepared in both English and Arabic. In the event of ambiguity or conflict between the two versions, the English language version will prevail.

SECTION 3. Except as specifically amended or modified herein, the Grant Agreement shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with all of its terms.

SECTION 4. Effectiveness. This Amendment shall enter into force when signed by both parties hereto.

SECTION 5. Ratification. The Grantee will take all necessary action to complete all legal procedures necessary to ratification of this Amendment and will notify USAID as promptly as possible of the fact of such ratification.
