guided by their desire to continue the "Arrangement between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission of the United States of America and the Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation and Nuclear Safety of the Federal Republic of Germany for the Exchange of Information and Cooperation in Nuclear Safety Matters", signed on October 19, 1995,

have agreed as follows:


Article 1

The "Arrangement between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission of the United States of America and the Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation and Nuclear Safety of the Federal Republic of Germany for the Exchange of Information and Cooperation in Nuclear Safety Matters", signed on October 19, 1995, shall be extended for another five-year period, with effect from October 19, 2000.

Article 2

This agreement shall enter into force by signature of both contracting parties.

Done in Bonn on the 24th day of January 2002 in two original texts in the English and German languages, both texts being equally authentic.
