

AMENDMENT ONE
TO THE
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE
OF
THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
AND THE
DEPARTMENT OF NATIONAL DEFENCE OF CANADA
CONCERNING
THE EXCHANGE OF DEFENCE
PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL

1. The Department of Defense (DOD) of the United States of America and the Department of National Defence of Canada (DND) entered into a Memorandum of Understanding Concerning the Exchange of Defence Professional Personnel (EDPP MOU) on 2 October 1991 for a period of 10 years. Under Amendment One, the Participants hereby extend the EDPP MOU for a period of one year.
2. In accordance with Section X (DURATION, AMENDMENT AND TERMINATION) of the EDPP MOU, the Participants hereby mutually agree to extend the EDPP MOU for one year. This Amendment will enter into force upon the date of the last signature, with an effective date of 2 October, 1991.
3. All other provisions of the EDPP MOU remain unchanged.
4. The undersigned being duly authorized, have signed this Amendment One in English, in duplicate.
