**AMENDMENT 4 TO**

**MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION**  
**AIA/CA-46**

**BETWEEN THE**

**FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION**  
**DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**  
**UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**

**AND THE**

**MONTREAL, CANADA**

**ARTICLE I—GENERAL**

Under the provisions set forth by Article VI of Memorandum of Cooperation (MOC) AIA/CA-46, the MOC is hereby amended as follows.

**ARTICLE II—CHANGES****A. Article IV – FUNDING.**

The first paragraph shall be replaced with the following:

The FAA share of the estimated costs for this program of cooperation for the next three (3) years will be six hundred seventy five thousand U.S. dollars (\$675,000). The breakdown of estimated costs to the FAA is as follows:

1) October 1, 2000 to September 30, 2001	\$225,000
2) October 1, 2001 to September 30, 2002	\$225,000
3) October 1, 2002 to September 30, 2003	<u>\$225,000</u>
Total Amount	\$675,000

The second paragraph shall be amended by replacing the FAA address with the following:

**B. Article VIII – EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERMINATION.**

The first sentence shall be replaced with the following:

This MOC shall enter into force on the date of the last signature. All other provisions of the MOC shall remain in force until terminated.

**ARTICLE III – ENTRY INTO FORCE**

This Amendment shall enter into force on the date of the last signature. All other provisions of the MOA remain in force.

**ARTICLE IV – AUTHORITY**

The FAA and ICAO agree to the provisions of this Amendment as indicated by the signature of their duly authorized representatives.
