First Amendment, dated 28 JUN 2000 to the Results Package Grant Agreement, dated September 22, 1999, between the Arab Republic of Egypt ("A.R.E.") and the United States of America, acting through the United States Agency for International Development ("USAID") (collectively, the "Parties") for Development Support Program I.

SECTION 1. The Grant Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

A. Section 2.1 is amended by deleting "Two Hundred Million United States Dollars (\$200,000,000)" and substituting "Four Hundred Million United States Dollars (\$400,000,000)" therefor.

SECTION 2. Language of Amendment. This Amendment is prepared in both English and Arabic. In the event of ambiguity or conflict between the two versions, the English language version will prevail.

SECTION 3. Effectiveness. Except as specifically amended or modified herein, the Grant Agreement shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with all of its terms.


SECTION 4. Effectiveness. This Amendment shall enter into force when signed by both Parties hereto.

SECTION 5. Ratification. The A.R.E. will take all necessary action to complete all legal procedures necessary to ratification of this Amendment and will notify USAID as promptly as possible of the fact of such ratification.


