

AMENDMENT TO THE
 AGREEMENT
 BETWEEN
 THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OF THE
 UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
 AND
 THE EXPERT AND TECHNICAL COMMITTEE OF
 THE CABINET OF MINISTERS OF UKRAINE
 CONCERNING
 THE PROVISION OF ASSISTANCE TO UKRAINE
 RELATED TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
 AN EXPORT CONTROL SYSTEM
 TO PREVENT THE PROLIFERATION OF
 WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION FROM UKRAINE

Pursuant to Article VIII of the Agreement between the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Expert and Technical Committee of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine Concerning the Provision of Assistance to Ukraine Related to the Establishment of an Export Control System to Prevent the Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction from Ukraine of December 5, 1993, as amended on March 21, 1994, June 27, 1995, and extended on December 6, 1995, hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement," the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the State Export Control Service of Ukraine, successor of the Expert and Technical Committee of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine, hereby agree to extend the Agreement for one additional year, until December 5, 1998.

Pursuant to Article VIII of the Agreement, the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the State Export Control Service of Ukraine hereby agree to amend the Agreement by replacing the words "13.26 million U.S. dollars" in Article III, paragraph 1, with the words "thirteen million eight hundred ninety thousand U.S. dollars."

This Amendment shall enter into force upon signature, with effect from December 5, 1997, and shall remain in force for the duration of the Agreement.
