


AMENDMENT NUMBER 3
TO THE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE
OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
AND THE
MINISTER OF DEFENSE OF THE FRENCH REPUBLIC
REGARDING
THE EXCHANGE OF ENGINEERS AND SCIENTISTS

The Secretary of Defense of the Government of the United States of America and the Minister of Defense of the French Republic, hereinafter referred to as the "Parties", entered into the Agreement between the Secretary of Defense of the Government of the United States of America and the Minister of Defense of the Government of the French Republic regarding the Exchange of Engineers and Scientists, hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement," dated 28 January 1994, as amended and extended 28 May 2004 and 22 August 2005. In accordance with paragraph 1 of Article VII (Duration, Termination and Entry into Force), the Parties agree to extend and amend the Agreement further as follows:

1. The Agreement is extended until 31 January 2010.
2. This Amendment Number 3 to this Agreement will enter into force on the date on which the last signature is affixed below.
3. This Amendment Number 3 is signed in the English and French languages, both texts being equally authentic.
