

Amendment to
the Agreement Between
the Department of Defense of the United States of America
and the Federal Space Agency
Concerning Cooperation in the Elimination of
Strategic Offensive Arms

Pursuant to Article VIII of the Agreement Between the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Federal Space Agency Concerning Cooperation in the Elimination of Strategic Offensive Arms, dated August 26, 1993, as amended April 3, 1995, June 19, 1995, May 27, 1996, April 11, 1997, February 11, 1998, June 9, 1998, August 16, 1999, August 8, 2000, June 9, 2003, September 25, 2003, and January 14, 2005, and as amended and extended August 30, 2002, hereinafter referred to as the Agreement,


The Department of Defense of the United States of America (DoD) and the Federal Space Agency (Roscosmos), which is an Executive Agent for the Russian Federation to implement the Agreement Between the United States of America and the Russian Federation Concerning the Safe and Secure Transportation, Storage and Destruction of Weapons and the Prevention of Weapons Proliferation (with respect to the elimination of strategic missile complexes and heavy bombers), hereinafter referred to as the Parties, have agreed as follows:

To amend Article III, Paragraph 1 of the Agreement by replacing the words "one billion, one hundred thirty-two million, nine hundred seventy thousand U.S. Dollars" with the words "one billion, one hundred ninety-three million U.S. Dollars".

This Amendment shall enter into force upon the date of its signature by both Parties and shall remain in force for the duration of the Agreement.

Done at Washington this 15th day of May, 2006, and at Moscow, this 25 day of MAY, 2006, in duplicate, each in the English and Russian languages, both texts being equally authentic.
