

**AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT***between***THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE OF GEORGIA***and***THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OF THE UNITED STATES OF  
AMERICA****"CONCERNING COOPERATION IN THE AREA OF  
PREVENTION OF PROLIFERATION OF  
TECHNOLOGY, PATHOGENS AND EXPERTISE  
RELATED TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF  
BIOLOGICAL WEAPONS"**


Pursuant to Article VII of the Agreement between the Ministry of Defense of Georgia and the Department of Defense of the United States of America "*Concerning Cooperation In The Area Of Prevention Of Proliferation Of Technology, Pathogens And Expertise Related To The Development Of Biological Weapons*", dated December 30, 2002, as amended in March 23, 2004, August 30, 2004, November 3, 2005 and June 23, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"), the Ministry of Defense of Georgia and the Department of Defense of the United States of America hereby agree to amend Article III, Paragraph 1 by replacing the words "ninety five (95) million" with the words "one hundred twenty five (125) million".

This Amendment shall enter into force upon the date on which the parties exchange written notifications confirming the completion by each Party of all applicable internal procedures required for the entry into force of the Amendment, and it shall remain in force for the duration of the Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, being duly authorized by their respective governments, have signed this Amendment.

Done at Tbilisi, this 26 day of February, 2007, and at Washington, this 6 day of March, 2007, in two duplicate, each in the Georgian and English languages, both texts being equally authentic.
