

DEPUTY, INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENTS

1. The Department of Defense (DoD) of the United States of America and the Department of National Defence of Canada (DND) entered into a Memorandum of Understanding Concerning the Exchange of Defence Professional Personnel (EDPP MOU) on October 2, 1991 for a period of ten (10) years. Amendments One through Five extended the EDPP MOU until October 2, 2008.
2. In accordance with Section 10 (Duration, Amendment and Termination) of the EDPP MOU, the Participants hereby mutually agree to extend the EDPP MOU for an additional two years until October 2, 2010. This Amendment will enter into effect upon the date of the last signature.
3. All other provisions of the EDPP MOU remain unchanged.
4. The undersigned, being duly authorized, have signed this Amendment Six in English, in duplicate.
