NEW STORM SEWERS AND WATER MAINS IN SHERIDAN-KALORAMA

The Department of State has been informed by the Government of the District of Columbia that a major construction project will begin during July 2009 in the Sheridan-Kalorama neighborhood. This project will involve the installation of new storm sewer pipes and water mains along several streets. A map of the affected area is attached along with a description of the project from the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority (DCWASA). The approximate locations of the affected foreign mission properties, both office and residential, are indicated.

Once completed, the project will benefit all property owners in the neighborhood. However, since the work will involve major roadwork on various blocks over a two year period, the day to day impact on foreign missions properties in the area will be significant, particularly during daytime hours.

All missions indicated on the map should be aware that parking, including reserved diplomatic parking, will be prohibited along the portions of the street that are being excavated for the installation of the new sewer pipes and water mains. According to DC WASA, the parking prohibition will be during the hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm Monday through Friday while construction is underway on a block. **“NO PARKING”** signs will be posted. Missions should plan accordingly.
