

AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OF THE
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
AND
THE FEDERAL AGENCY FOR INDUSTRY
CONCERNING
THE SAFE, SECURE AND ECOLOGICALLY SOUND DESTRUCTION
OF CHEMICAL WEAPONS
OF JULY 30, 1992, AS AMENDED

Pursuant to Article VII of the Agreement Between the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Federal Agency for Industry Concerning the Safe, Secure and Ecologically Sound Destruction of Chemical Weapons, dated July 30, 1992, as amended March 18, 1994, May 28, 1996, April 10, 1997, December 29, 1997, January 14, 1999, November 14, 2000, August 29, 2002, October 23, 2002, March 17, 2003, March 18, 2003, September 23, 2003, July 28, 2004, October 6, 2005, and September 8, 2006, hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement," the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Federal Agency for Industry hereby agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. To replace the words "one billion ninety-two million forty-seven thousand U.S. dollars" in Article III, Paragraph 1 of the Agreement with the words "one billion one hundred thirty-four million seven hundred forty-seven thousand U.S. dollars."

2. To insert a new paragraph 2 into Article III as follows, and renumber the remaining paragraphs of Article III accordingly:

"2. Considering the need to commission the CWDF in 2008, the DoD and the Federal Agency for Industry, taking into account the need to reorganize their management system of the CWDF construction for the purpose of decreasing management costs, shall develop and sign not later than May 23, 2007, the joint arrangement concerning the completion of the CWDF construction. This joint arrangement shall determine the procedure for awarding, implementing, and paying contracts for completing construction and commissioning of the CWDF."

This amendment shall enter into force on the day of its signature by both parties and shall remain in force for the duration of the Agreement.

Done in Washington, this 21st day of May 2007, and in Moscow, this 17 day of May 2007, in duplicate, each in the English and Russian languages, both texts being equally authentic.
