### THE STRATEGIC OBJECTIVE GRANT AGREEMENT

AMENDMENT NUMBER TWENTY TO THE STRATEGIC OBJECTIVE GRANT AGREEMENT between the Government of the United States of America, acting through the United States Agency for International Development ("USAID"), and the Government of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan (hereinafter referred to as the "Grantee" or the "GIRoA"), acting through the Ministry of Finance, dated as of December 15, 2009.

WHEREAS, the Grantee and USAID entered into a Strategic Objective Grant Agreement ("SOAG") for the Strategic Objective of "A Thriving Economy Led by the Private Sector" (USAID Grant Agreement No. SOAG-306-05-00), dated September 19, 2005 and subsequently amended that SOAG on:

- September 30, 2005 (Amendment No. 1);
- April 6, 2006 (Amendment No. 2);
- May 11, 2006 (Amendment No. 3);
- June 28, 2006 (Amendment No. 4);
- September 18, 2006 (Amendment No. 5);
- September 30, 2006 (Amendment No. 6);
- April 07, 2007 (Amendment No. 7);
- July 2, 2007 (Amendment No. 8);
- July 23, 2007 (Amendment No. 9);
- September 19, 2007 (Amendment No. 10);
- September 30, 2007 (Amendment No. 11);
- April 10, 2008 (Amendment No. 12);
- May 29, 2008 (Amendment No. 13);
- September 21, 2008 (Amendment No. 14);
- September 25, 2008 (Amendment No. 15);
- December 04, 2008 (Amendment No. 16);
- March 01, 2009 (Amendment No.17) through PIL # 13;
- May 25, 2009 (Amendment No. 18) through PIL # 14; and
- September 2009 (Amendment No. 19).

The SOAG so amended is referred to hereinafter as the "Agreement."

WHEREAS, USAID and the Grantee desire to further amend the Agreement to: (a) increase the USAID contribution by **Two Hundred Seventy-Four Million Eight Hundred Thirty Thousand United States (U.S.) Dollars (U.S. \$274,830,000.00)**; and (b) update the illustrative financial plan to reflect certain adjustments and to cross reference and cross-walk the original SOAG budget information against the new USAID standardized program budget structure

WHEREAS, USAID and GIRoA acknowledge that programming decisions for the use of these funds shall be made in coordination with the appropriate Ministry, and such decisions shall be recorded in Project Implementation Letters (PILs) with countersignatures by the relevant Minister and the Minister of Finance.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereto hereby agree that the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

1. The first sentence in Section 3.1(a) of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof: "(a) The Grant. To help achieve the Objective set forth in this Agreement, USAID, pursuant to the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, hereby grants to the Grantee under the terms of this Agreement not to exceed **Three Billion Three Hundred Twenty Six Million Eight Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand Ninety-Seven and Eighty-Two Hundredths United States (U.S.) Dollars (U.S. \$3,326,888,097.82)** (the 'Grant')."
2. The first sentence in paragraph (b) of Section 3.1 of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted in lieu thereof: "(b) Total Estimated USAID Contribution. USAID's total estimated contribution to achievement of the Objective will be U.S. \$3,326,888,097.82 which will be provided in increments."
3. The paragraph in Section 4 (a) of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety (to extend the completion date from December 31, 2010 to December 31, 2011) and the following is substituted in Lieu thereof: "The completion date, which is December 31, 2011, or such other date as the Parties may agree to in writing, is the date by which the Parties estimate that all the activities necessary to achieve the Objective and Intermediate Result will be completed".
4. The illustrative financial plan set forth in Attachment 1 to Annex 1 to the Agreement is deleted and the updated illustrative financial plan attached hereto as Attachment A and Attachment B to this Amendment is substituted in lieu thereof.


