- the authorization and extension of diplomatic and consular importation privileges to eligible foreign missions and their members;
- the identification and handling of foreign diplomatic pouches transiting to, within, or from the United States;
- the authorization and extension of benefits under the Department's Airport Escort Screening Courtesies Program; and
- when warranted, the development and imposition of restrictions on travel within the United States of foreign mission members.
