**SECOND AMENDMENT

SECOND AMENDMENT, dated April 8, 2009, to the Grant Agreement between the Republic of Lebanon (“Grantee”), represented by the Ministry of Finance, and the United States of America, acting through the United States Agency for International development (“USAID”), for Post-Conflict Cash Transfer Assistance, as last amended on December 17, 2007 (the Grant Agreement as so amended is referred to herein as the “Agreement”).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Grantee and USAID hereby agree as follows:

SECTION 1. USAID Contribution. Section 3.1 of Article III of the Agreement is amended by deleting “One Hundred Twenty-Five Million United States (“US”) Dollars (\$125,000,000)” and substituting “One Hundred Seventy-Five Million United States (“US”) Dollars (\$175,000,000)” therefor.

SECTION 2. Terminal Date for Disbursement. Section 5.3 of Article V of the Agreement is amended by deleting “September 30, 2009” and substituting “May 30, 2010” therefor.

SECTION 3. Effect. Except as specifically amended or modified herein, the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with all of its terms.

SECTION 4. Ratification. The Grantee will take all necessary action to complete all legal procedures necessary for ratification of this Second Amendment and will notify USAID of such actions.

SECTION 5. Entry in Force. This Second Amendment shall enter into force when signed by both the Grantee and USAID.
