


AMENDMENT NUMBER 4  
TO THE AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE

REGARDING  
THE EXCHANGE OF ENGINEERS AND SCIENTISTS


The Secretary of Defense of the Government of the United States of America and the Minister of Defense of the French Republic, hereinafter referred to as the "Parties," entered into the Agreement between the Secretary of Defense of the Government of the United States of America and the Minister of Defense of the French Republic regarding the Exchange of Engineers and Scientists, hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement," dated January 28, 1994, as amended and extended May 28, 2004, August 22, 2005, and January 29, 2008. In accordance with paragraph 1 of Article VII (Duration, Termination and Entry into Force), the Parties agree to extend and amend the Agreement further as follows:

1. The Agreement is extended until January 31, 2011.
2. This Amendment Number 4 to this Agreement will enter into force on the date on which the last signature is affixed below.
3. This Amendment Number 4 is signed in the English and French languages, both texts being equally authentic.
