

**AMENDMENT 1 TO**  
**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**  
**NAT-I-5408**  
**BETWEEN THE**  
**FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION**  
**DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**  
**UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**  
**AND THE**  
**CIVIL AVIATION REGULATORY COMMISSION**  
**HASHEMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN**

**ARTICLE I—GENERAL**

Pursuant to the terms of Article VIII of Memorandum of Agreement NAT-I-5408 (the “Agreement”) between the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) of the Department of Transportation of the United States of America and the Civil Aviation Regulatory Commission of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan (collectively, “the Parties”), the Parties agree to amend the Agreement and Annexes 1 and 2 to the Agreement as follows.

**ARTICLE II—AMENDMENTS**

Recognizing that the Civil Aviation Regulatory Commission is the successor to the Civil Aviation Authority, the Parties agree to replace all references to the “Civil Aviation Authority” with references to “Civil Aviation Regulatory Commission” throughout the text of the Agreement and Annexes 1 and 2 to the Agreement. All amendments, annexes, and appendices to the Agreement subsequently entered into shall be entered into in the name of the “Civil Aviation Regulatory Commission.”

**ARTICLE III—ENTRY INTO FORCE**


This Amendment shall enter into force on the date of the last signature and shall remain in force so long as the Agreement remains in force.
