Dated: September 17, 2010

Amendment No. 7 to the Assistance Agreement between United States of America, acting through the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and the Republic of the Philippines ("the Grantee") (collectively, the "Parties") for Mindanao Peace and Development ("the Agreement") dated September 19, 2007.

SECTION 1. The Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

A. Article 3, Section 3.1 (a) of the Agreement is hereby amended by deleting "Seventy Five Million Two Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Two Hundred Ten United States (U.S.) Dollars (\$75,249,210)" and substituting in lieu thereof "One Hundred Million Eight Hundred Fifty Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty Three United States (U.S.) Dollars (\$100,857,923)."


B. The Attachment (Illustrative Financial Plan) to Annex I (Amplified Description) of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and the attached Attachment 1 to Annex 1 is substituted in lieu thereof.

SECTION 2. Except as specifically amended or modified herein the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with all of its terms.

SECTION 3. Effectiveness. This Amendment No. 7 shall enter into force when signed by both Parties hereto.


