Sixth Amendment to the Strategic Objective Grant Agreement for Strategic Objective 3: "Improved Family Health Sustainably Achieved" between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Republic of the Philippines ("the Agreement") dated September 27, 2006.

SECTION I: This Sixth Amendment hereby amends the Agreement as follows:

A. Article 3 (Contribution of the Parties):

1. Section 3.1 (USAID Contribution):

Section 3.1(a) of the Agreement is hereby amended by deleting "Ninety Seven Million Three Hundred Thirty Five Thousand One Hundred Forty Seven United States (U.S.)dollars (\$97,335,147)" and substituting in lieu thereof "One Hundred Thirty Million Two Hundred Sixteen Thousand One Hundred Forty Seven United States U.S. dollars (\$130,216,147)."

Section 3.1(b) of the Agreement is hereby amended by deleting "U.S. 125,000,000" and substituting in lieu thereof "One Hundred Thirty Million Two Hundred Sixteen Thousand One Hundred Forty Seven U.S. Dollars (\$130,216,147)."

2. Section 3.2 (Grantee Contribution): Section 3.2 of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

Section 3.2 (Grantee Contribution):

(a) The Grantee's contribution will not be less than the equivalent of Forty Eight Million Six Hundred Forty Thousand U.S. Dollars (\$48,640,000), including in-kind contributions. The Grantee will report at least annually in a format to be agreed upon with USAID on its cash and "in-kind" contributions.

3. The Attachment (Illustrative Financial Plan) to Annex I (Amplified Description) of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and the attached Attachment 1 to Annex 1 is substituted in lieu thereof.

SECTION II: Except as specifically amended or modified herein the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with all of its terms.


SECTION III: This Sixth Amendment shall enter into force when signed by both Parties hereto.

Either party may unilaterally, with written notice to the other, adjust line items in this budget to a maximum of 15 percent per line item provided, however, that the total obligated amount, as shown in the budget is not exceeded; the total contribution by the Grantee is not reduced; and the amount budgeted for "Program Design and Learning; and Administration and Oversight" is not reduced.

Note 1:

The total counterpart contribution of \$48,640,000 (Pesos 2,236,671,570) maybe in cash or in-kind, and included \$5,235,000 (Pesos 248,180,000) in cash expenditures to cover estimated VAT, including E-VAT, assessed on U.S.A.I.D.-financed goods and services pursuant to Section 3.2(b) of this Agreement. The counterpart contribution was recomputed every time additional USAID funds were obligated to the Agreement. For purposes of determining the peso equivalent, the counterpart contribution was computed using the exchange rate at the time of the obligation.


