

AMENDMENT I TO
ACQUISITION AND CROSS-SERVICING AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
AND
THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE OF THE KINGDOM OF SPAIN

The Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Ministry of Defense of the Kingdom of Spain, hereinafter referred to as the Parties, pursuant to Article VIII of the Acquisition and Cross-Servicing Agreement between the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Ministry of Defense of the Kingdom of Spain (the "Agreement"), which entered into force May 19, 1999, mutually agree to amend the Agreement by deleting Article VIII in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

"VIII. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERMINATION


1. This Agreement, which consists of a Preamble, Articles I through VIII, and Annexes A and B, shall become effective on the date of the last signature and shall remain in force for a period of twelve years unless terminated by either Party giving not less than 180 days notice in writing to the other Party."

This amendment shall enter into force upon signature by both of the Parties.
