

**AMENDMENT NUMBER SIXTEEN TO THE
STRATEGIC OBJECTIVE GRANT AGREEMENT**

BETWEEN

**The United Republic of Tanzania, represented by
The Ministry of Finance and Economic Affairs (the "GOT")**

AND

**The United States of America, acting through
The United States Agency for International Development ("USAID")**

This is Amendment Number Sixteen to the Strategic Objective Grant Agreement for Strategic Objective 10, Enhanced Multisectoral Response to HIV/AIDS, dated June 7, 2005 (as amended, the "Agreement"), between USAID and the GOT (together, the "Parties"), as amended by the Parties through Amendment Number One on September 26, 2005, Amendment Number Two on March 20, 2006, Amendment Number Three on May 6, 2006, Amendment Number Four on September 25, 2006, Amendment Number Five on March 01, 2007, Amendment Number Six on May 03, 2007, Amendment Number Seven on July 11, 2007, Amendment Number Eight on September 26, 2007, Amendment Number Nine on May 08, 2008, Amendment Number Ten on August 28, 2008, Amendment Number Eleven on September 22, 2008, Amendment Number Twelve on September 10, 2009, Amendment Number Thirteen on September 28, 2009, Amendment Number Fourteen on August 15, 2010 and Amendment Number Fifteen on September 24, 2010.

WHEREAS, the Parties hereto desire to make an amendment to the Agreement by increasing the USAID grant by an additional increment of Thirty-Seven Million, One Hundred Eight Seven Thousand, Seven Hundred Sixteen-U.S. Dollars (\$37,187,716) for the purpose of providing additional funding for HIV/AIDS prevention, treatment, and care activities, and aligning the budget consistent therewith;

NOW THEREFORE, the Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

1. Article 3: Contribution of Parties, Section 3.1 (a) is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

“(a) The Grant. To help achieve the Objectives set forth in the Agreement, USAID, pursuant to the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, hereby grants to the GOT under the terms of this Agreement, as amended, an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Eighty-Five Million, Six Hundred Nineteen Thousand, Two Hundred Twelve U.S. Dollars (\$ 485,619,212) for the purpose of providing funding for HIV/AIDS prevention, treatment, and care activities.”

2. Article 3: Contribution of Parties, Section 3.1 (b), is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

“(b) Total Estimated USAID Contribution. The total estimated contribution of USAID under this Agreement is expected to be Six Hundred Sixty-Six Million, Seven Hundred-Twenty Thousand, Eight Hundred Thirty-Two U.S. Dollars (\$666,720,832), which is to be provided in incremental funding. Of this sum, Six Hundred Sixty-Six Million, Seven Hundred-Twenty Thousand, Eight Hundred Thirty-Two U.S. Dollars (\$666,720,832) has been contributed to date, of which Four Hundred Eighty-Five Million, Six Hundred Nineteen Thousand, Two-Hundred Twelve U.S. Dollars (\$485,619,212) have been granted directly to the GOT under this Agreement; and One Hundred Eighty Million, Nine Hundred Sixty Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred Eighty U.S. Dollars (\$180,969,980) have been obligated by USAID/Washington directly into grants or contracts to carry out activities in Tanzania in furtherance of the objective under this Agreement. Subsequent increments are subject to the availability of funds to USAID for this purpose and the mutual agreement of the Parties, at the time of each subsequent increment, to proceed.”

3. The Illustrative Financial Plan for Annex 1 for the Strategic Objective 621-0010.01-15 is deleted in its entirety and the attached Sixteenth Amendment Illustrative Financial Plan, (Attachment A hereto), is substituted therefor.

4. Except as amended herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the United States of America and the Government of the United Republic of Tanzania, each acting through its respective duly authorized representatives, have caused this Amendment Number Sixteen to be made effective as of the day and year first written above.
