NOTE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE

Pursuant to Public Law 89—497, approved July 8, 1966

AGREEMENT EXTENDING THE ARRANGEMENT  
BETWEEN  
THE UNITED STATES NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION  
AND  
THE AUTHORITY FOR NUCLEAR SAFETY AND RADIATION  
PROTECTION OF THE NETHERLANDS  
FOR THE EXCHANGE OF TECHNICAL INFORMATION AND  
COOPERATION IN NUCLEAR SAFETY MATTERS

The United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (USNRC) and the Authority for Nuclear Safety and Radiation Protection of the Netherlands (ANVS), hereinafter "the Parties;"

Recalling the Arrangement Between the USNRC and the Department of Nuclear and Radiation Safety, Security and Safeguards (KFD) of The Netherlands for the Exchange of Technical Information and Cooperation In Nuclear Safety Matters, signed at Vienna on September 18, 2013 (the Arrangement), which by its terms will expire on September 18, 2015; and

Recognizing that the KFD has been succeeded by the ANVS; and

Guided by their desire to continue cooperation under the Arrangement as envisaged by Section IV.D. of the Arrangement;

Hereby agree as follows:

1. The duration of the Arrangement shall be extended for one year. The Arrangement shall therefore remain in force until September 18, 2016.
2. All references in the Arrangement to “the Department of Nuclear and Radiation Safety, Security and Safeguards” and “KFD” shall be replaced by references to “the Authority for Nuclear Safety and Radiation Protection” and “ANVS,” respectively.
3. This Agreement shall enter into force upon signature of the Parties.


