### **DDOT Expands Rush Hour Parking Restrictions for SafeTrack**

The Department of State wishes to inform all Embassies of recent changes made by the District's Department of Transportation (DDOT) regarding rush-hour parking restrictions to alleviate traffic issues caused by [WMATA's SafeTrack](#). The information provided below outlines the new restrictions that will impact some reserved, diplomatic parking.

#### **DDOT Traffic Mitigation**

Extended morning (7am-10am) and evening (4pm-7pm) rush-hour parking restrictions have been implemented and will remain in effect on the corridors listed below for the duration of SafeTrack. **In order to avoid being ticketed, all Embassy personnel must adhere to the extended rush-hour parking restrictions (including those areas where reserved, diplomatic parking is in place) until SafeTrack has concluded and the signs are removed.**

Traffic Management will be maintained using the following:

- Enhanced real-time retiming of traffic signals
- Traffic control officers deployed at key intersections
- Roadway Operations Patrols during rush hours
- Additional staging areas for Metro buses

Additionally, Capital Bikeshare is now available for \$2 per single-trip fare.
