

**AMENDMENT 5  
TO THE  
IMPLEMENTING AGREEMENT ON BORDER SECURITY ASSISTANCE  
BETWEEN THE  
DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA  
AND THE  
MINISTRY OF DEFENSE OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN**

The Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Ministry of Defense of the Republic of Uzbekistan, hereinafter the Parties;

Pursuant to Article 6 of the Implementing Agreement on Border Security Assistance between the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Ministry of Defense of the Republic of Uzbekistan, dated June 2, 2000, as amended (hereinafter the Implementing Agreement),


Have agreed as follows:

1. To amend Article 3 of the Implementing Agreement by replacing the words "thirty-seven million U.S. dollars" with the words "forty-four million U.S. dollars."

This Amendment shall enter into force upon signature by both Parties and shall remain in force for the duration of the Implementing Agreement.

Done at Washington, this 5<sup>th</sup> day of January 2006, and at Tashkent, this 14 day of 12 2006, in duplicate, each in the English and the Russian languages, both texts being equally authentic.
