## AMENDMENT NO (5)

Amendment Five to the Agreement Between the Department of Defence of the United States of America, as Represented by the Defence Logistics Agency Energy, and the Ministry of Defence of Sultanate of Oman, as Represented by the Royal Air Force of Oman, Concerning the Provision of Petroleum Products and Related Services.

The following is Amendment Five to the Agreement Between the Department of Defence of the United States of America (U.S. DoD), as Represented by the Defence Energy Support Center (DLA Energy), and the Ministry of Defence of the Sultanate of Oman (Oman MOD), as Represented by the Royal Air Force of Oman (RAFO), Concerning the Provision of Petroleum Products and Related Services (Agreement), which entered into force on September 19, 2008, as amended on August 12, 2012, February 11, 2014, October 8, 2015, and March 28, 2016.

The Oman MOD and the U.S. DoD shall also be referred to individually as the "Party" and collectively as the "parties" as the context requires.

WHEREAS the Parties have entered into an Agreement concerning the provision of Petroleum products and related services, wherein RAFO shall provide petroleum products and related services to the U.S. DoD and U.S. Federal Civilian Agencies at Masirah, Thumrait, and AL Musanah airbases within the Sultanate of Oman, for which the U.S. DoD will reimburse RAFO for the support provided;

AND WHEREAS the Parties have entered into Amendment One dated August 12, 2012, Amendment Two dated February 11, 2014, Amendment Three dated October 8, 2015, and Amendment Four dated March 28, 2016.

IT IS NOW AGREED by and between the Parties that the changes to the Agreement, as amended, specified below, as well as the additional terms and conditions contained herein, shall be made a part of the Agreement, as amended, as follows:

1. The Parties mutually agree in accordance with paragraph 6.9. of Section

VI (General Provisions) of the Agreement, as amended, to delete paragraph 6.12. of Section VI (General Provisions) of the Agreement, as amended, and replace it with the following:

**6.12. Effective Date and Duration.** This Agreement shall enter into force on September 19, 2016 and shall remain in force until September 18, 2018 or upon conclusion of a new fuel agreement between the Parties concerning the provision of petroleum products and related services, whichever event occurs first, subject to exercise of termination rights as set forth in paragraph 6.7 of this Agreement.

2. All other provisions of the Agreement, as amended remain unchanged. This Amendment Five shall remain in force for as long as the Agreement it amends.

3. In accordance with paragraph 6.9. of Section VI (General Provisions) of the Agreement as amended, Amendment Five shall enter into force upon the last signature of the Parties.


