NOTE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE

Pursuant to Public Law 89—497, approved July 8, 1966
(80 Stat. 271; 1 U.S.C. 113)—

“ . . .the Treaties and Other International Acts Series issued under the authority of the Secretary of State shall be competent evidence . . . of the treaties, international agreements other than treaties, and proclamations by the President of such treaties and international agreements other than treaties, as the case may be, therein contained, in all the courts of law and equity and of maritime jurisdiction, and in all the tribunals and public offices of the United States, and of the several States, without any further proof or authentication thereof.”

The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia, and has the honor to refer to the Agreement Between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Malaysia Concerning the Establishment of the Malaysian-American Commission on Educational Exchange (MACEE) signed at Kuala Lumpur on September 20, 2010 and entered into force September 20, 2010, with effect from August 3, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement").

The Embassy, on behalf of the Government of the United States of America, proposes that, pursuant to Article XVII.3 of the Agreement, the Agreement be extended for an additional ten-year period, i.e., through August 3, 2025.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Ministry, the Embassy proposes that this note, and the Ministry's note in reply to that effect, shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments to extend and amend the Agreement, which shall enter into force on the date of the Ministry's note in reply, and with effect from August 3, 2015.

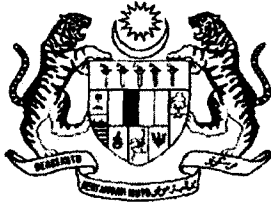
The Embassy of the United States of America avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs the assurances of its highest consideration.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia presents its compliments to the Embassy of the United States of America and acknowledges receipt of Embassy note No. 1082 dated 5 October 2015, regarding the Agreement between the Government of Malaysia and the Government of the United States of America Concerning the Establishment of the Malaysian-American Commission on Educational Exchange (MACEE) signed at Kuala Lumpur on 20 September 2010 and entered into force 20 September 2010, with effect from 3 August 2005 (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"), which reads as follows:

"The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia, and has the honor to refer to the Agreement Between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Malaysia Concerning the Establishment of the Malaysian-American Commission on Educational Exchange (MACEE) signed at Kuala Lumpur September 20, 2010 and entered into force September 20, 2010, with effect from August 3, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement").

The Embassy, on behalf of the Government of the United States of America, proposes that, pursuant to Article XVII.3 of the Agreement, the Agreement be extended for an additional ten-year period, i.e., through August 3, 2025.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Ministry, the Embassy proposes that this note, and the Ministry's Note in reply to that effect, shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments to extend and amend the Agreement, which shall enter into force on the date of the Ministry's note in reply, and with effect from August 3, 2015.

The Embassy of the United States of America avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia the assurances of its highest consideration."

The Ministry, on behalf of the Government of Malaysia, confirms that the proposal contained in the Embassy's note is acceptable. Therefore, the Embassy's note and this note in reply shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments to extend the Agreement, which shall enter into force on the date of this note, and with effect from 3 August 2015.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy of the United States of America the assurances of its highest consideration.
