U.S. Government Entities Combating Human Trafficking in American Indian & Alaska Native (AI/AN) Communities

Department of the Interior (DOI)

Bureau of Indian Affairs (DOI BIA) conducts law enforcement investigations, conducts anti-trafficking T&TA to tribes, and provides victim assistance.

Department of Health & Human Services (HHS)

Office of Intergovernmental & External Affairs (HHS IEA) leads HHS policy and programming related to tribal and AI/AN communities.

Indian Health Service (HHS IHS) provides direct services to AI/AN trafficking victims and provides T&TA to tribes and service providers to address sexual violence, including sex trafficking.
