Citibank No Longer Accepts Shell Gasoline Credit Card Applications for Tax-Exempt Gasoline Credit Cards

The Office of Foreign Missions (OFM) has learned that as of October 1, 2018, Citibank will no longer issue Shell tax-exempt gasoline credit card accounts for eligible foreign missions and their personnel in the United States. All requests for Shell accounts through Citibank submitted after October 1 will be returned back to missions. OFM will provide an update on the status of the existing accounts and availability of new Shell accounts as they become available. Eligible foreign missions and their personnel may still obtain personal and official tax-exempt gasoline accounts from Citibank for ExxonMobil.
