Personal Tax-Exempt Accounts Now Available with Chevron/Texaco Gasoline Credit Card Accounts

The Office of Foreign Missions (OFM) wishes to reference its Notice dated January 8, 2019 regarding Chevron/Texaco Gasoline Credit Card Accounts.

OFM has learned that WEX will now accept both Chevron/Texaco individually-billed personal gasoline exempt credit cards for the personal use of foreign mission personnel and mission gasoline tax-exempt credit cards for the official use of foreign missions. Eligible members of foreign missions must submit a new request for Exemption from Gasoline Taxes with a **new** Chevron/Texaco gasoline credit card application via the Department's eGov system. The credit card application can be found on OFM's website at <https://www.state.gov/ofm/tax/gas/applications/index.htm>. The members must also now include a copy of a voided check, along with the credit card application to obtain a Chevron/Texaco credit card account. Please make sure that the credit card applications and voided checks are submitted to OFM via eGov. Members of foreign missions located in New York must also upload via eGov Form FT-505.1, *Government Entity Credit Card Refund or Credit Election*.
