U.S. Census 2020 Seminar – Diplomats Count!

On May 23, 2019, the Office of Foreign Missions (OFM) will host a seminar with officials of the U.S. Census Bureau for the Washington, DC-based foreign mission community. The purpose of this event will allow U.S. Census Bureau leaders to convey the importance of U.S. based members of the diplomatic community and their families participating in the upcoming 2020 Census, the utility of both decennial census and other Census Bureau data to foreign missions, and an overview of key operations, and communications and partnership efforts.

The event will begin at **10am** and will take place at the Foreign Missions Center. Entrance to the event is at the intersection of Dahlia Street, NW and Alaska Ave, NW (see enclosed site map). The duration of this event is anticipated to be approximately 2 hours. Free parking is available on site.

Due to space limitations no more than 2 representatives per mission can be accommodated. If the room capacity fails to match the demand for this seminar, OFM will work with the U.S. Census Bureau to schedule a second opportunity. Further, such discussions are already underway to organize similar discussions in other U.S. cities hosting large numbers of foreign consular posts.
