Asiana Airlines Flight 214 crash in San Francisco

Asiana Airlines Flight 214 crashed in San Francisco, California at 11:36 local time (PDT). On board were reported 291 passengers and 16 crew members. As of 6:00 pm PDT, local authorities report that 181 persons are being treated at local hospitals (49 with serious injuries), 123 persons are uninjured and remain at the airport, and two fatalities at the scene.

The Office of Foreign Missions (OFM) has already reached out to the consulates of all known countries impacted based upon the citizenship of passengers reported in the manifest. There are 3 passengers of nationalities unknown to the Department at this time.

We will continue to monitor the situation closely and as additional information is developed concerning any fatality or injury to a foreign national, OFM San Francisco will inform the consulate or embassy concerned immediately.

We ask that private citizens from your countries work with you, and that you contact OFM San Francisco at 202-341-5328 or 415-307-2433 if you need assistance with contacting local authorities.
