The District of Columbia Declares Snow Emergency

The Office of Foreign Missions (OFM) wishes to inform the foreign mission community that the District of Columbia has declared a Snow Emergency effective 6:30 p.m. tonight, Wednesday, February 12, 2014 until further notice.

All vehicles parked on designated snow emergency routes will be subject to a \$250 fine, plus towing and storage fees. Several of the foreign missions are located on designated snow emergency routes that include the following major arteries:

Connecticut Avenue NW – K Street to Western Avenue
Massachusetts Avenue NW – Western Avenue to North Capitol Street
Nebraska Avenue NW – Indian Lane and Chain Bridge Rd. to Military Road
Wisconsin Avenue NW – K Street to Western Avenue
